### Description

A blend of longleaf, short leaf and loblolly pines, our Bunkhouse Plank® Yellow Pine floors are made from well-aged barn framing members that had originally been circular sawn. These floors are dramatically rustic. Planks range in color from medium to deep and have the original old-time circular sawcut marks. Also included are blackened nail holes, insect marks and weathered cracks. Aged Woods® Bunkhouse Plank® Yellow Pine is an extremely rustic hardwood floor with maximum character and patina.

- \* All planks are kiln-dried to 8%, +/-2% before being milled and graded to our consistently high standards by trimming out defects and waste.
- \* Unfinished - needs light sanding or simply screening after installation before finishing with the finish of your choice
- \* Plank thickness: 3/4" (1/2" in some widths/ranges)
- \* Single width planks: 2-1/2" up to 12" (and wider depending on availability)
- \* Plank length: 18" - 12'
- \* Typically sold in ranges of four consecutive widths: 3" to 6", 4" to 7" and 5" to 8" with other ranges available. (Some of each width in the range is included in every order, e.g. 3" to 6" will contain 3", 4", 5" and 6" planks)
- \* Most popular: 3" to 6" range
