

ANTIQUÉ DISTRESSED® AMERICAN CHESTNUT

Description

Our rare Antique Distressed® American Chestnut flooring is made from barn siding and other weathered barn wood. Planks have a distinctive grain pattern and range in color from medium honey to dark chocolate and contain evidence of their age and their former life including circular sawcut marks, blackened nail holes, insect marks, weathered cracks and a lot of patina. An Aged Woods® Antique Distressed® American Chestnut floor is uniquely beautiful with maximum character and maximum patina.

Due to a blight, this species went extinct in the beginning of the 20th century. Efforts are under way to revive it by hybridizing, but reclaiming is the only source for authentic American Chestnut, *Castanea Dentata*.

- * All planks are kiln-dried to 8%, +/-2% before being milled and graded to our consistently high standards by trimming out defects and waste.
- * Unfinished - needs light sanding after installation before finishing with the finish of your choice
- * Plank thickness: 3/4" (1/2" in some widths/ranges)
- * Single width planks: 2-1/2" up to 12" (and wider depending on availability)
- * Plank length: 18" - 12'
- * Typically sold in ranges of four consecutive widths: 3" to 6", 4" to 7" and 5" to 8" with other ranges available. (Some of each width in the range is included in every order, e.g. 3" to 6" will contain 3", 4", 5" and 6" planks)
